



DISINFECTANTS & RESTROOM CLEANERS **HOW TO MAKE DISINFECTANTS WORK**

Time

The longer bacteria are exposed to germicide the higher the percentage of bacteria is killed. Ten minutes is the best wait time. Allow at least three to five minutes of exposure. Keep surface wet with solution during this period.

Temperature

The higher the temperature of water in the disinfectant, the faster and more complete the disinfectant activity. Use the hottest water available.

Solution

Get the surface wet. The more solution used in disinfecting a contaminated surface, the more germicide is available to attack germs. Wet mop floors, picking up excess with a damp mop.
